

Carol singing in Antigua.

On the evening of Friday the 19th of December a group of approximately 25 Street Pastors and friends went out onto the streets of the capital St John's to bring the sounds of Christmas to the late night shoppers and those in the clubs and bars.

They started by singing inside the branch of the food chain Subway which every Friday donates sandwiches, cookies and drinks which are taken out onto the streets for distribution to the homeless. After leaving Subway the group stopped and sang on a number of street corners with passers by joining in with the singing.

They were even invited to sing inside one of the bars.



They walked across to the other side of town and sang in the street outside a number of venues including a lap dancing club. In total they were out for two and a half hours, a great time was had by everybody and there were also some opportunities to speak with individuals and a couple of people asked for prayer.
