## Enfield Street Pastors. Are you interested?

A Street Pastor is a member of a local church who has chosen to respond positively to the night time problems of a town, engaging with people on the streets by caring, listening and directing them towards essential services, as well as providing a reassuring presence for people who might feel nervous or anxious, particularly those who are vulnerable and have perhaps dropped through the net. Street Pastors are volunteers.

## On Patrol

Currently, ESPs are patrolling in Edmonton, Enfield Town and Southgate/Palmers Green. We have helped many people by being a listening ear, showing care and concern and attempting to follow up those who have wanted to talk further. We have bought food for a couple of homeless men and lent our mobile phone to those who have missed the last bus home so they could phone for a lift. We have been a visible reassurance on the streets. When we've been asked we have prayed for people and talked about our faith, and why we are out and about at that time of night (or morning!)

## Enfield Street Pastors. Yes I'm interested

If you are interested in becoming involved with Enfield Street Pastors, here is what is needed to keep us on the road? We need...

### 1: More Prayer

Prayer is vital to the work of Enfield Street Pastors. Before any team goes on patrol they have a time of prayer together. We need Prayer Partners because prayer makes such a difference - prayer changes things!

We need people who will meet to pray while a team is on patrol. We need people to back specific pastors in prayer. We need people who will receive the team report and pray for the people contacted.

Please consider giving some time to praying for us and being a vital part of what we're doing.

### 2: More Pastors

Currently there are around thirty Street Pastors in Enfield split into four teams but we need more pastors.

Anyone who is a committed Christian, a member of a local church, and who is endorsed by the leadership of that church can become a Street Pastor. You need to be over 18 (no upper age limit), and able to commit to a 12 session training course in three groups of four Saturdays spread over five months, and to a minimum of 12 nights a year on the streets.

The course includes subjects such as counselling skills, drugs awareness, sociology, knowing your community, roles and responsibilities, and street safety. You may be surprised to learn that the average Street Pastor is a 50 year old lady. The training begins in March and September each year.

Please pray about being a part of taking the church onto the streets and training as a pastor.

### 3: More Pounds

Any organisation needs finance and Enfield Street Pastors is no exception. We pay a part-time coordinator who liaises with the Police and Local Authorities, acting as an advocate on behalf of vulnerable people we have met. We also need finance for all that running an office entails, and for those extra items like keeping the First Aid kits supplied.

Please consider a one-off gift or, better still, taking out a standing order.
