TAUNTON M5 VIGIL

THE VIGIL planned for Friday night next to the scene of the M5 crash in which seven people were killed and dozens injured has been scaled back for safety reasons.

A spokesman for Taunton Street Pastors who are organising the vigil in Sainsbury's car park next to the motorway in Taunton said: "acting on the advice of the authorities, attendance will now be restricted only to those workers who were directly involved in the emergency last Friday and those who have had a personal invitation.
