## TOTNES PRAYER FESTIVAL

Based on the colours of the rainbow, each area featured flowers, Bible verses, poems, pictures and artefacts focussing on various aspects of our community with room to sit and pray, be still or read.

The Festival ended with an Ecumenical Service during which groups gathered in each of the prayer zones for guided prayers for the community.
