Totnes Street Pastors

The Street Pastor Scheme has proved to be a great success in Torbay. Inspector Paul Morgan, with the support of the Totnes Town Council and the Clergy of the Churches Together in Totnes has been very keen to set up a Street Pastor Initiative here in Totnes too.

However, the needs in Totnes are quite different to those in Torbay and the Inspector has been especially concerned about vulnerable young people who gather around the Plains and Vire Island on Friday nights. With the Pubs staying open an hour longer now, he has asked Street Pastors to be available from 10pm - 2pm to come alongside (non judgementally) listening, caring and helping thus freeing up the Police to respond to more pressing concerns.

Street Pastors are Church based with prayer support throughout the evening. It costs around £300 to train and equip a Street Pastor and we ask applicants to seek sponsorship and fund themselves. We are fund raising as well so that we can help equip Street Pastors who would struggle to find the money and we would be very grateful for any support that you would wish to give.
